

'As students begin to engage with the discipline, as they move from exposure to experience, they begin to understand that ... different communities ... are quite distinct,... 


### Pharmacy at Reading

- Professional Body requirements integrated into the degree course
- Also have <u>CMS</u> a compulsory Part 2 course that provides students with advice on all aspects of planning their career
- $\bullet$  Now also need to prepare students for engagement in CPD

'CPD is mandatory for all practising pharmacists registered with the RPSGB from 2009. You will be encouraged to record your learning in the format required by the RPSGB from the earliest possible opportunity in your undergraduate career'.
